**ABSTRACT PRESENTERS** – You are asked to connect through a dedicated link (<a href="https://zoom.us/j/91696809933">https://zoom.us/j/91696809933</a>) at least 30 minutes before your involvement.

You'll then be greeted by one of the technicians who will lead you to the assigned session at the agreed time.

*Please note*: the provided link will only be valid for 12-13 November. If you are involved in December sessions, you will be provided with a different link closer to the event.

If you're not involved in a session or you took part in October sessions as abstract presenter, you can enter the EUGA 2020 Virtual Platform by using the credentials you already received.

Abstract Presenters will therefore be able to access the meeting in 2 different ways:

- Zoom link with direct connection to technicians and to a dedicates virtual room if you need to attend a session as an Abstract Presenter
- Personal credentials to enter the virtual platform and attend as a delegate.

Please make sure to click on the Zoom link at least 30 minutes before the session you are involved in.
